Intro to Design; Teaching Artist: Juliana Rodriguez

Ages 8-10: Monday and Wednesdays; 4 - 5 PM

This workshop will combine foundation principles of drawing with the development of young artists' unique points of view. We'll start by focusing on fundamental drawing techniques such as line, shape, composition, and perspective, and explore architectural themes, history, and artists. Each young artist will create a final project exploring an idea. The workshop will reflect on what it means for our community to practice design.

Intro to Concept Art; Teaching Artist: Marius Marjolin

Ages 11-14: Mondays and Wednesdays; 4 - 5 PM

Create a world with characters, creatures and it's own environment all from scratch. Concept art is at the core of developing TV shows, cartoons, movies and video games. It's used to develop the aesthetic, atmosphere, costumes, set pieces, backgrounds and overall "culture" of a fictional world/character. In Intro to Concept Art, young artists will build skills in drawing, character design, creative writing and work towards a collective final project.

Textile Experiments; Teaching Artist: Aja Delgado

Ages 11-14: Tuesdays and Thursdays; 4 - 5 PM

Uncover the world of textile (fabric) techniques! Textile experiments will introduce young artists to dying techniques, fabric modification and clothing customization as well as basic sewing techniques. Students will learn fabric dying techniques from ancient Japan to modern American methods and explore the role of color in our past and peasant culture(s). Textile Experiments participants will batique, shibori, ice dye, reverse tie dye and create a personal project.

Clay Studio; Teaching Artists: Mary Lindberg

Ages 8-10; Tuesdays and Thursdays; 4 - 5 PM

Learn how to create with clay! Clay Studio introduces young artists to the world of ceramic arts. In this hands-on workshop, students will build techniques in building clay sculptures, beads, and usable bowls, cups and plates. Methods of surface decoration and glazing will also be introduced and explored.
